


<p>Course Title</p>	<p>Lino Relief Printmaking</p>				
<p>Course Description</p>	<p>This course is intended as an introduction for those who wish to explore and experiment with graphic printmaking process of reduction lino printing. There will be short demos to show new techniques and processes along the way. Work will be self-directed with personal projects being achieved for each student.</p> <p>The course will initially explore creative drawing and recording with still life and observational drawing before transferring the image onto lino in preparation for carving.</p> <p>Reduction printing processes will allow for graphic images to be produced using a range of different colours and mark making techniques which could make personalised Christmas cards or a small edition of prints.</p> <p>Further experimentation with mixed media and hand colouring prints can also be explored if time allows.</p> <p>At the end of the course you will be able to take away your own edition of prints and cards.</p>
