Course Title	Introduction To Mosaics				
Course Description	Have fun creating colourful handmade mosaics. No previous mosaicking experience is necessary. Try out basic tiling techniques to make mosaic coasters using glass tiles (no tile cutting or jagged edges are involved). Then learn how to mix and apply grout to your creations for that finished look. We will also consider how colours and shapes work together, plus other aspects of mosaic design. By the end of the day, you will have completed your own beautiful mosaic coasters, which can be used in the home. These items will be both decorative and functional, and also make delightful gifts. All work will be carried out in class, with guidance and supervision. Whilst all abilities are welcome, this day school is ideally suited to those with no or basic mosaicking experience. There is no requirement to have attended my previous day schools or evening classes. All materials and equipment are provided. Material costs are included.

- Gain skills, confidence and inspiration in designing and making mosaics
