<p>Course Title</p>					<p>Mosaics – an introduction</p>
<p>Course Description</p>	<p>Have fun creating colourful handmade mosaics. No previous mosaicking experience is necessary. Learn simple tiling techniques using various tile materials on different bases. Then learn how to mix and apply grout to your mosaics for that finished look. We will also consider how colours and shapes work together, plus other aspects of mosaic design.</p> <p>By the end of the course, you will have several of your own mosaic creations including coasters, flowerpots and other homewares. These items will be both ornamental and functional, and can make delightful gifts.</p> <p>All work will be carried out in class, with guidance and supervision. Whilst all abilities are welcome, this course is ideally suited to those with no or basic mosaicking experience. There is no requirement to have attended my previous day schools or evening classes.</p> <p>All materials and equipment are provided. Material costs are included.</p>
