## FREE COURSES

Some of our courses are funded through the Adult Education Budget allocated by the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority (CPCA) or the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) and part financed by the European Social Fund Plus (ESF+) programme. This funding is managed by Cambridgeshire Skills, Cambridgeshire County Council. These courses are fully funded if you have lived in the EEA for at least 3 years. Funding is also available if you have recently arrived from Ukraine or are currently living here and holding a British Nationals Overseas (BNO) visa.
