Skills or qualifications needed for entry into the class			<p>You will have a done at least a year of Spanish and have a working knowledge of Spanish including exchanging greetings and personal information; using numbers and time; expressing opinions and using the present tense/gender/adjectives/prepositions accurately.</p>		
Course aims & objectives					
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The course will enable learners to communicate effectively and use the past, present and future tenses accurately. Learners will be taught techniques on how to obtain information from complex spoken and written texts on familiar and unfamiliar topics. • To encourage confidence in the development of listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and we will learn in a lot of different ways to suit most learning styles using a variety of activities: lectures, demonstrations, games, Q & A sessions, work sheets, written exercises, handouts, re-caps and revision. • To provide a lively, stimulating and interesting base for group, individual, and pair work. • To develop individual and group knowledge of the Spanish language in a fun informal way. This 					

includes expanding vocabulary, practising using different tenses, and investigating further specific grammar points.

Progression – after this course what might you do next?

It is hoped that learners will read in and speak Spanish confidently while abroad or whilst conversing with native Spanish-speakers. Learners might also consider a GCSE/ A-level in Spanish.

How progress & success will be recorded

The tutor will always be available to talk about individuals' specific needs and talk about progress. There will be continuous oral and written formative assessment and feedback during the course.

Materials/equipment required for first class

This course will be taught online using Zoom, therefore you will need access to equipment that can run this program and a reliable internet connection. All materials will be provided by the course tutor and will be sent out prior to the lesson enabling learners to prepare for the class. A small English-Spanish dictionary will be useful although it could be replaced by an online one such as wordreference.com.

You will also need a notebook and pen, and notes in Spanish to help you introduce yourself at the beginning of the first class. (5 sentences max.)
