This includes expanding vocabulary, practising using different tenses, and investigating further specific grammar points.						

Progression – after this course what might you do next?	
It is hoped that learners will read in and speak Spanish confidently while abroad or whilst conversing with native Spanish-speakers. Learners might consider an intermediate 2 level after finishing this course.	
How progress & success will be recorded	
The tutor will always be available to talk about individuals' specific needs and talk about progress. There will be continuous oral and written formative assessment and feedback during the course.
