<p>Whether you are experienced watercolour artist, a master of arts, or someone who would like to try as a complete beginner, this course will offer you something unique. We are a friendly bunch of people all working together to improve our artistic abilities. The aim of this course is to introduce you to different styles of watercolour painting by looking at various artists' work each week. It is a practical course and participants are encouraged to produce a watercolour painting during each session.</p> <p>Paper stretching, benefits of different types of paintbrushes and papers, colour mixing and the use of perspective are some of the topics covered. The course is tailored to explore the participants' areas of interest with the aim of building confidence and improving the skills and quality of work over the course.</p>

Materials/equipment required for first class	<p>Please bring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Brush washing jar (jam jar will do) x2 - Apron (if you feel you might need them) - Tissue paper or kitchen roll - Good quality watercolour brushes of different sizes - A sketchbook A4 or A5 to draw out initial ideas. - Watercolour paper preferably 300 gsm, A4 or bigger, either individual sheets or a block or pad. - Watercolour paint in either tubes or pans. Lemon yellow, cadmium yellow, ultramarine, phthalo blue, raw and burn umber, yellow ochre, vermilion or similar warm red, pinkish red, black and white. - Pencils: HB, 4H, - Eraser
